This 14 day photographic expedition is an "Exploratory Tour", our very first journey into Tibet. The itinerary has been planned with the help of local experts and good friends, but please note that changes to the schedule and destinations are possible. Exploratory trips are genuine adventures, so expect the unexpected and enjoy this rare chance to see a professional travel photographer dropped into the thick of it.

Day 1 Chengdu - Sichuan Dining, Giant Pandas, Tibet Permits
Days 2-5 Lhasa - Flight to Lhasa Potala Palace, Markets, Drepung and Sera
Days 6-7 Samye - Remote Villages, Drolma Lakhang, Yambu Lakhang
Days 8-9 Gyantse - High Passes, Yamdrok-Tso Lake, Gyantse Dzong Sunset
Days 10-11 Shigatse - Tashilhunpo Monastery and excursion to Sakya
Days 12-13 Lhasa - Journey along Brahmaputra River and vist scenic Ganden
Day 14 Chengdu - Flight back to Chendgu is included

Photographic Themes

People of any skill level will benefit from the photographic guidance included with this journey. In addition to one-on-one tuition with the instructing photographer, you will receive specialised notes to follow through the journey with a series of photographic themes to apply and discuss at key destinations.

Level of Comfort

The style of travel in Tibet is varied. Some nights will be four star hotels, and others will be basic guesthouses in remote villages. We aim to venture far and wide, but rest well every evening. All transport is privately catered to ensure safety and comfort. You won't need to carry your bags much further than from the bus to your hotel room.
